Yardage Page Revision:

BACKGROUNDS & BORDERS (Hoffman ID numbers included)

yardage needed

- Dark purple batik:** (multi color) Q2136 N45-New Grape: 1/2 yard
- *Deep purple hand-dye:** 1895 N45-New Grape 1/2 yard

(* previously was "Deeper purple hand-dye")

Page One Clarifications:

The Background *Create borders as shown and then trim length to fit after attaching.

CUT:	First Strip	Second Strip	Piece
Dark purple batik	8 1/4"	4"	
Deep purple hand-dye	7 1/2"	4"	
Green batik	-----	-----	12 1/2" x 21"
Light purple	7/8"		
Magenta	2 1/4"		
Blue/turquoise dot	7/8"		
Bright green	-----	-----	4" square

Begin by cutting the strips & pieces from your fabrics as shown at left. (Cut strips selvedge to selvedge.)

Next cut off the pieces as shown **Figure A.** from your 7 1/2" deep purple had-dye strip and turquoise dot fabric strip. Assemble the bottom border. Iron seams and set aside.

Cut and assemble the right side border as shown **Figure B** from your 4" deep

purple hand-dye strip and bright green square. Now measure to fit, trim and attach the four borders to the center as shown in **Figure C.** (Align the bright green square 2 1/4" from the bottom of the center piece and trim excess border.) Iron the seams away from center and trim edges even.

(deep purple hand-dye & turquoise dot)

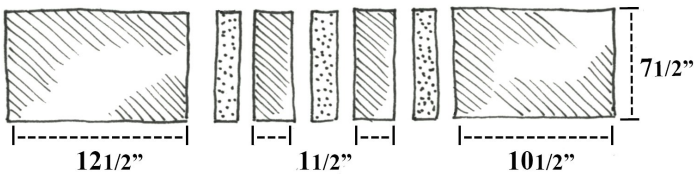
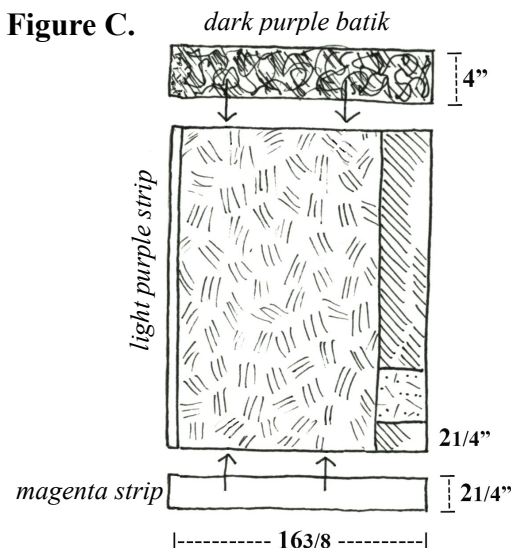
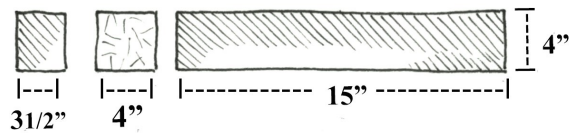


Figure B. right side border
